COVID-19 UpdateWe are all in this Together

As you know, we are all facing unprecedented times due to the COVID-19 pandemic. West River Cooperative Telephone 456-2635 Company wants you to know that we are all in this together! WRCTC has a vested interest in the continued success of our communities now, and after the pandemic is over. - 1. We have postponed all non-essential network upgrades to minimize service interruptions.
- 2. In mid-March, due to the anticipated increase of our member's internet bandwidth usage, WRCTC increased the capacity of its connection to the internet.
- 3. We have upgraded critical equipment in our network to mitigate network congestion due to more internet usage during this time.
- 4. We are constantly monitoring our network to identify any potential causes of service interruptions or network congestion before they happen.
- 5. We have ensured that all elementary and high school students in our service area have access to broadband while they are learning from home.
- 6. We have ensured that all teachers in our service area have enough bandwidth to allow them to teach their students via video conference.
- 7. We have provided the free use of our business conference bridge system for business entities to help maintain their business continuity while practicing social distancing.
- 8. We have increased the capacity of our business conference bridge system due to the increase in usage.

SDTA to Award \$4,000 in 2020 Scholarships

The South Dakota Telecommunications Association (SDTA) annually 257-2637 awards scholarships under two separate programs or scholarship funds administered by the South Dakota Community Foundation, those two programs/funds include our "SDTA Memorial Scholarships" and our "Brian Meyer Memorial Scholarships."

This year, for the fall 2020 college semester, (SDTA) will be awarding two scholarships of \$2,000 under its Memorial Scholarship Program. The deadline to apply for these Scholarships is May 31, 2020. To be eligible for the available Memorial Scholarship awards, you must have plans to attend or already be attending a college as a full-time student (taking at least 12 semester credit hours or its equivalent) and meet the following criteria:

- Have a High School Diploma or GED equivalent;
- Be accepted into or attending a multi-year program degree at any accredited technical college or other accredited post-secondary higher education institution in South Dakota for the fall 2020 semester;
- Be majoring in a degree/program or field of study that is useful in the telecommunications or broadband industry or which significantly relies on the use of broadband services and related technologies (see examples of majors eligible for this scholarship below); and
- Be a customer/member or have a parent or legal guardian who is a customer/member of a SDTA member company, such as West River Cooperative Telephone Company.

*Previous SDTA Memorial Scholarship recipients are not eligible to apply.

Examples of eligible majors or fields of study for the SDTA Memorial 244-5577 Scholarship include, but are not limited to: Telecommunications; WiFi and Broadband Technologies; Information Systems Technology; Satellite Communications; Health Information Technology; Office Technology Specialist; Programming Specialist; Network Specialist; Engineering (Computer Science or Systems, Electrical, CAD, Software, Industrial, Communications Systems, Network Security); Technologies or Computers (Communications Systems Engineering Technologies, Computer Programming, Computer Software Specialist, Computer Systems or Software, Computer Applications, Utilities Technologies, Network Technician, Internet Apps Developer, Laser/Electro-Optics, Marketing, Network Administration, System Administrator); Technology Education; and Communication Arts (Graphic Design or Mass Communications, Commercial Arts, Multimedia/Web Development.)

The scholarship application can be completed online, submitted by email to katie@sdtaonline.com or mailed hard-copy to: SDTA, PO Box 57, Pierre, SD 57501. Applications are available online at www. sdtaonline.com, from any South Dakota post-secondary institution student financial aid office, the SDTA office, or any SDTA member company.

Award selections 374-5689 will be announced on or about July 15th.

FRS Youth Tour CANCELED

Due to COVID-19 (coronavirus), FRS has been forced to cancel the 2020 Youth Tour. The cancellation takes into consideration the 244-5290 safety of students, chaperones, and staff, as well as the restrictions on gatherings, curtailment of transportation, and access to Capitol Hill and the FCC. FRS and WRCTC are very disappointed the 25th annual Youth Tour will not be taking place this summer, but we hope you understand.
