Starting in October, members that have a GigaCenter or GigaSpire will notice a change to their bill. Previous bill cycles show a specific charge on page 2 under: Description – Internet – **GIGA CENTER** ... \$10. The bill you get in the mail the first part of October will show the same setup but will now be listed as: Description – Internet – **Managed WiFi** ... \$10. These devices have been game changers when it comes to a wireless connection at member's homes. In the past, technicians would have to go to residences' if issues occurred with their internet. With Managed WiFi, technicians can troubleshoot over the phone



instead of having to make a trip! This reduces your internet downtime because issues can sometimes be resolved 202 6th Ave W, Lemmon; over the phone. 

Radar Issues on FiberVision TV

In July, the National Weather Service's Doppler Radar near New Underwood was damaged in a thunderstorm with tennis ball sized hail and 80 mph winds. 70%-80% of the panels on the radar were damaged. NWS Technicians decided it was time to rebuild the dome before any serious damage occurred on the inside of the dome. Due to the rebuilding process, the radar 13273 Milberg Rd, Newell; system was not available starting August 16, 2021 through September 3, 2021, when they finished the project.
