

FUSC Decrease

West River Cooperative Telephone members will see an decrease in the monthly Federal Universal Service Charge (FUSC) on their telephone bill effective January 1, 2022. A Federal Communications Commission (FCC) order 12726 Country Ln., Newell; changed the way telephone companies can recover their Federal Universal Fund contributions. The Federal Universal Service Fund Program is designed to help keep all local telephone service rates affordable for all customers, in all areas of the United States. Residential and single line businesses will decrease from \$1.89 to \$1.64 (.25 cent decrease). Multiple line businesses will decrease from \$3.55 to \$3.07 (.48 cent decrease). Please keep in mind that if you bundle your services, you do not see these charges as they are included in your flat bundle fee. If you're not bundled and would like to bundle your services, call the office today at 605-244-5213.
