Complete the first semester at your chosen post-secondary school. 2. Be enrolled as a full-time student. 3. Maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA throughout the program. Proof of enrollment and GPA transcript must be submitted to GEC/WRCTC after the first semester is complete and scholarship funds will then be applied to your account. If the student does not make it to the second semester, the scholarship funding will not be disbursed. All essays will be checked for Artificial Intelligence (AI) usage. If AI is detected, the submission will no longer be considered for review.
